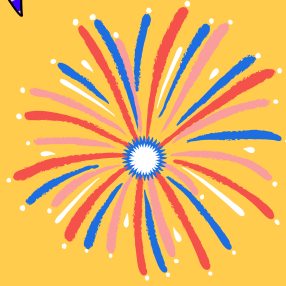
Guiding Cadets Towards Exam Confidence.
